Subject: Financial Sanction under National Post-Doctoral Fellowship to Dr. Jasia Nissar, under the mentorship of Prof. F.A. Masoodi, at Kashmir University, Hazratbal Rd, Hazratbal, Srinagar, JK, Srinagar, Jammu And Kashmir-190006- Release of 1st grant.

Sanction of Science and Engineering Research Board (SERB) is hereby accorded to the above mentioned fellowship at a total cost of Rs. 21,31,200/- (Rs. Twenty One Lakh Thirty One Thousand Two Hundred Only) for a duration of 24 months.

The date of start of the fellowship is effective from the date of joining in the host institute.

The items of expenditure for which the total allocation of Rs. 21,31,200/- has been approved are given below:

Sanction of the SERB is also accorded to the payment of Rs. 10,65,600/- (Rupees Ten Lakh Sixty Five Thousand Six Hundred only) under 'Grants-in-aid General' to Kashmir University, Hazratbal Rd, Hazratbal, Srinagar, JK being the first installment of the grant for the year 2019-2020 for implementation of the said research project.

3. The expenditure involved is debit to

Fund for Science & Engineering Research (FSER)

This release is being made under National Post Doctoral Fellowship (N-PDF). (Engineering Sciences)

4. The Sanction has been issued with the approval of the competent authority vide Diary No. SERB/F/10388/2019-2020 dated 18 February, 2020

5. Sanction of the grant is subject to the conditions as detailed in Terms & Conditions available at website (www.serb.gov.in)

6. Overhead expenses are meant for the host institute towards the cost for providing infrastructural facilities and general administrative support etc. including benefits to the staff employed in the project.

10. The institute will maintain separate audited accounts for the fellowship. A part or whole of the grant must be kept in an interest earning bank account which is to be reported to SERB. The interest thus earned will be treated as credit to the institute to be adjusted towards further installment of the grant.

11. The File no. PDF/2019/003069 may also be mentioned in all research communications arising from the above project with due acknowledgement of SERB.

12. As this is the first grant for the fellowship, no previous U/C is required.

13. The institute may refund any unspent balance to SERB by means of a Demand Draft favoring "UNIT FOR SCIENCE AND ENGINEERING RESEARCH" payable at New Delhi.
